ABSTRACT FOR ORAL PAPER PRESENTATION

- MS Word 2007/2010 Document. Word limit 200 words, font: Times New Roman, 12 Point, Heading -13 pt. Bold Space between lines 1.5
- Authors should mail their abstract and upon acceptance the authors should submit the hard copy of full paper, on A4 size paper with font size 12 in Times New Roman with 1.5 space, along with registration form and fees before scheduled date
- Only one paper will be allowed for one delegate.
- The details of the author must be enclosed i.e. Name of the author with Photograph, Designation, Title of the article, Name of affiliating institution, Mailing address, Telephone number & E-mail address & Abstract.(E-Mail to interionexgen.cncvcw@gmail.com)
- After peer review accepted papers will be **published** in the Conference proceedings with **ISBN number**. It should be ensured that the proposed paper on theme / sub theme has not been already published elsewhere. The paper should be original paper, covering case study, Research survey, Action plan, thematic approach rather than theoretical explanation. The authors should mention sub-theme of the paper under which it is to be covered.
- The review committee will have the right to reject, accept & edit the papers submitted for acceptance.
- The acceptance letter will be released after the scrutiny. Conference proceedings will include only those accepted papers for which the registration fee has been paid before **25th January 2020**.

- The manuscript must be typed in MS Word 2007/2010 with about maximum 3000 words and not exceeding 3 pages in a given template.
- References should be as per APA format.
