A total of 453 (out of 635) Students responded to the survey, the online feedback was taken on 5 point scale for interpretation of data, five points were considered

- The average score on all the questions was 76.74% (3.84) which indicates a good response from Students.
- The data with two highest scores of 78.45 % (3.92) and 77.88% (3.89) indicates that Syllabus includes skill development and Weightage is given to learning values (Knowledge application and skill concepts and analytical ability)
- The data with minimum score of 75.94% (3.80) and 75.76% (3.79) indicates Syllabus gives expected learning outcomes and focus more on inclusion of Entrepreneurship.

The details are as below:

- For Students → A white tunic top with gray stripes with $\frac{3}{4}$ " sleeves and roll down collar (shirt collar) for the student which has to be matched with black trousers/straight pair. Straight jeans only.
- For Staff → Blazers for staff in gray colour was finalized which was also designed by students of Fashion Design. There is a slight variation in blazer for male staff and female staff.

Female → No top, left pocket and with two slits at side.

Male → Single centre back slit with left pocket.

It was finalized that the uniforms will be used on three days of the week for both staff and students.




