





Types of Non-alcoholic beverages & their classification details.

Non-Alcoholic Beverages:-

A non-alcoholic beverage is one that contains little or no alcohol. This category includes low-alcohol beer, non-alcoholic wine, & apple cider if they contain less than 0.5% alcohol by volume.

Soft drinks:-

Beverages like soda pop, sparkling water, iced tea, lemonade, root beer, & fruit punch are the most common soft drinks.

Fruit juice :-

Fruit juice is a natural product that contains few or no additives. Coconut water is a highly nutritious & refreshing juice. Many kinds of berries are crushed and their juices mixed with water & sometimes sweetened.

Fruits are highly perishable, so the ability to extract juices and store them was of significant value. Some fruits are highly acidic.

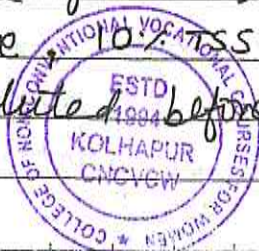
Fruit juices are of 2 types :-

- 1> Natural juice (only natural sugars)
- 2> Sweetened juice (85% juice & 10% TSS)

• RTS (Ready to serve) :-

This is type of fruit beverage contains at least 10% fruit juice, 10% TSS & 0.3% acid.

It is not diluted before serving.

Food preservation :

Food preservation is the maintenance of safe & nutritious food for an extended period of time. It is a process by which certain food like fruits and vegetables are prevented from getting spoiled for a long period of time. The colour, taste, nutritive value of the food is also preserved.

Ex - properly packed refrigerate frozen, canned & dried product.

Food preservation methodsPreservation by low temp.

Foods are stored at low temp. to prevent the growth of micro-organism activity of enzymes & purely chemical rean.

Freezing prevents the growth of most food borne micro-organism & refrigeration temp. slow down the growth of micro-organism.

Advantages of low temp.

Growth of the micro-organism and the enzymatic reactions in the food can be retarded by storing the food at low temp.

Lower the temp. longer is the duration for which food can be preserved. below 0°C.

The growth of rate of micro-organism & slow many of the physical & chemical rean that occurs in foods.

Freezing process is a combination of the beneficial effects of low temp. at which micro-organism cannot grow, chemical rean reduce & cellular metabolic rean are delayed.



cells cause much more physical rupture & separation of cells than do small crystals. large ice crystals damages is detrimental not only to cellular foods.

Uncontrolled cold also will damage foods. Fruits & vegetables allowed to freeze they suffer discoloration change in texture or cracked skins. leaving the foods susceptible to attack by micro-organisms.

Freezing may also cause deterioration of food quality. Foods

Initial investment & cost of maintaining a freezer is high.

Storage space is limited by how much the freezer will hold.

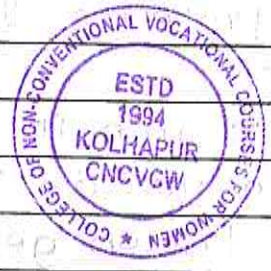

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
