Vote of Thanks was proposed by Ar. Nirali K Gilbile and the Alumni Meet for the Academic Year 2020-21 was successful concluded.

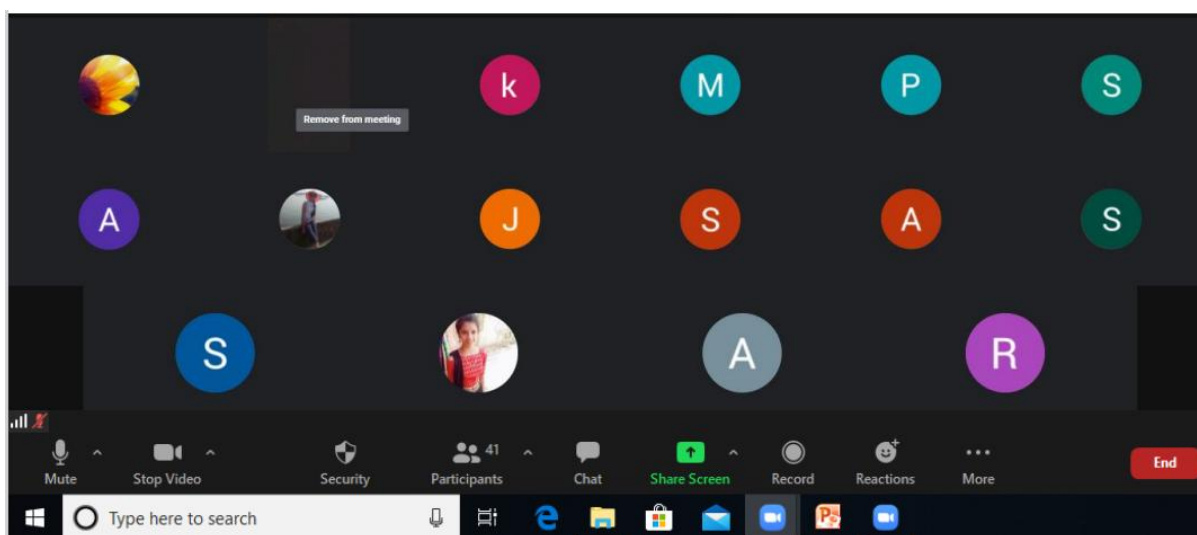


Figure 1 SCREENSHOT OF ZOOM MEETING PARTICIPATS

Mrs Pradnya P Kapdi, Organising secretary first wel the chief guest and presented the vote of thanks for the inaugural function.



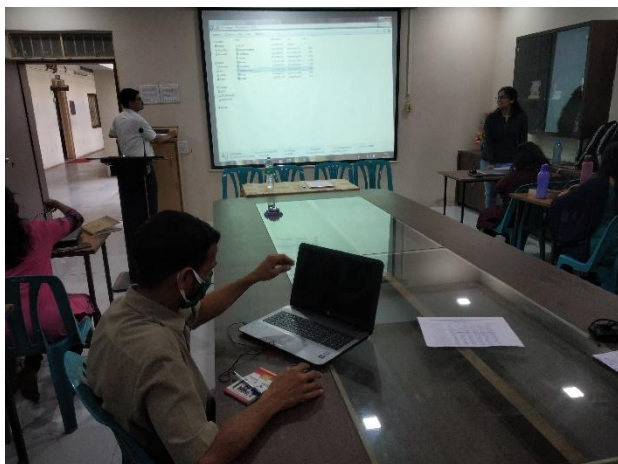

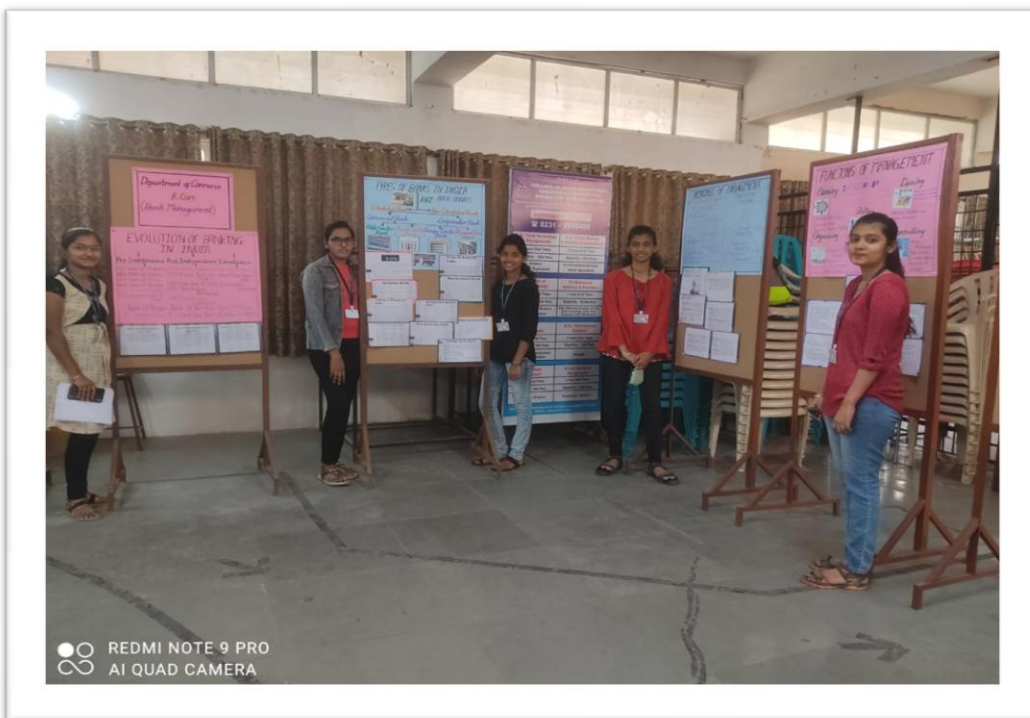

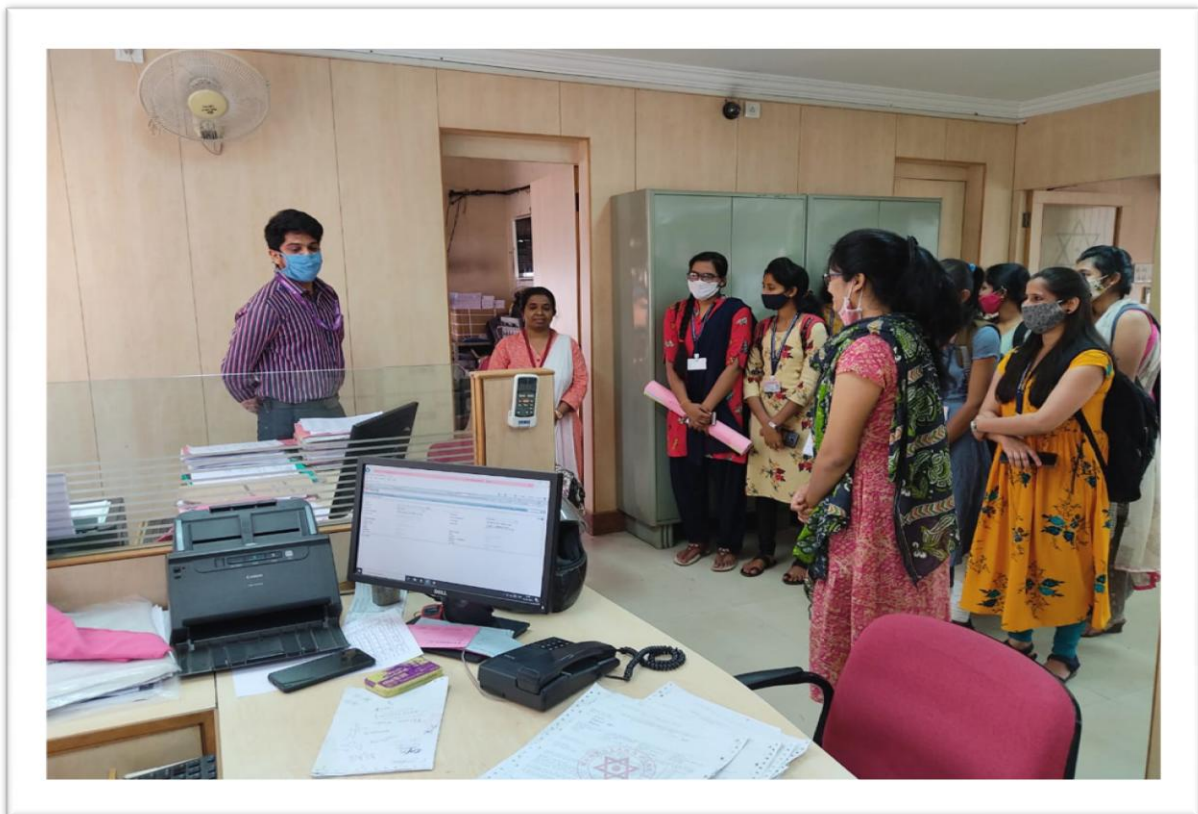
