4<sup>th</sup> September 2019

The College of Non-Conventional Vocational Courses for Women (CNCVCW), Kolhapur took initiative for helping flood victims in in Kolhapur and Sangli District of Maharashtra. Principal sir, Head of each department and office representative under the guidance of Dr.D.N - Valvi Department of Social Work came together and came to a conclusion to help the affected schools by providing them with educational kits and other equipment's. It was also decided to raise some funds for the same.

All the members decided to help the schools in Khidrapur from Shirol Taluka, District Kolhapur. Police Patil Mrs Deepali Patil of Khirapur was communicated for the detailed information. A team of five members was formed to survey the schools on location to know the exact needs. The team visited Khidrapur on 28<sup>th</sup> August 2019 and found that there are two schools here 1) Marathi Vidya Mandir with 150 students and 2) Urdu school with 51 students. Basic needs of school of books and bags were already fulfilled. Their next requirements were noted down.

After this visit the team members reported the details of the requirements of the school and as per the funds available it was decided to provide the various equipment's (Annexure 1). The entire activity was well very carried out and the Management and Principal appreciated the efforts taken by the staff and students for this activity.




