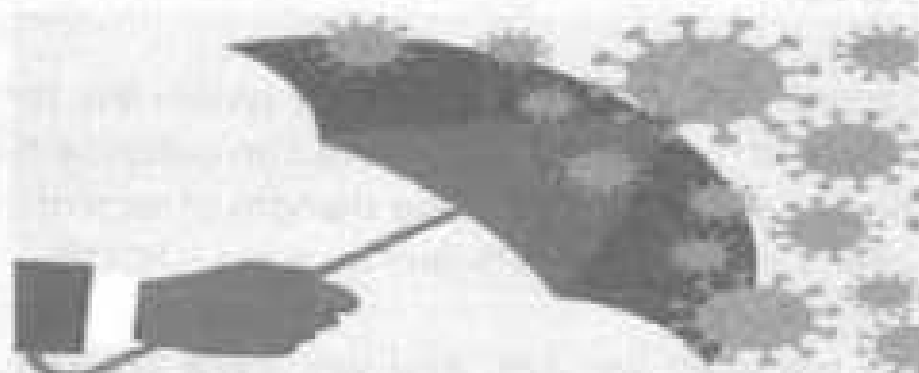

PREVENTION

As with other respiratory infections like the flu or common cold, Public health measures are critical to slow the spread of illness.

Public Health measures are everyday preventive actions that include:

1. Staying home when sick.
2. Wearing mask when going out.
3. Following rules of social distancing (distance of at least 1 meter).
4. Avoiding crowded places.
5. Covering mouth and nose with flexed elbow or tissue when coughing or sneezing.
6. Disposal of used tissue immediately.
7. Washing hands often with soap and water.
8. Cleaning frequently touched surfaces and objects.
9. Seeking medical advice immediately if fallen ill.



Balanced Nutrition at all ages and at all times holds a key for this.

4 Feeding our body certain foods may help keep our immune system strong. Here, in the context of COVID-19; the focus is more on super foods and Anti-viral foods. Consuming fresh foods, have balanced diet, be physically active, sleeping well & to reduce stress is a key to improve immune system and this is the first thing to prevent infection.

4 Limited access to fresh food & eating highly processed foods like high sugar, high salt & high fat may lead to weaken the immune system. So choose the foods with high nutritive value which are affordable, easily available & have fairly long shelf life.

4 We can better plan our meals by including these super foods and anti-viral foods. This will certainly help us to increase our immune power.

SUPER FOODS

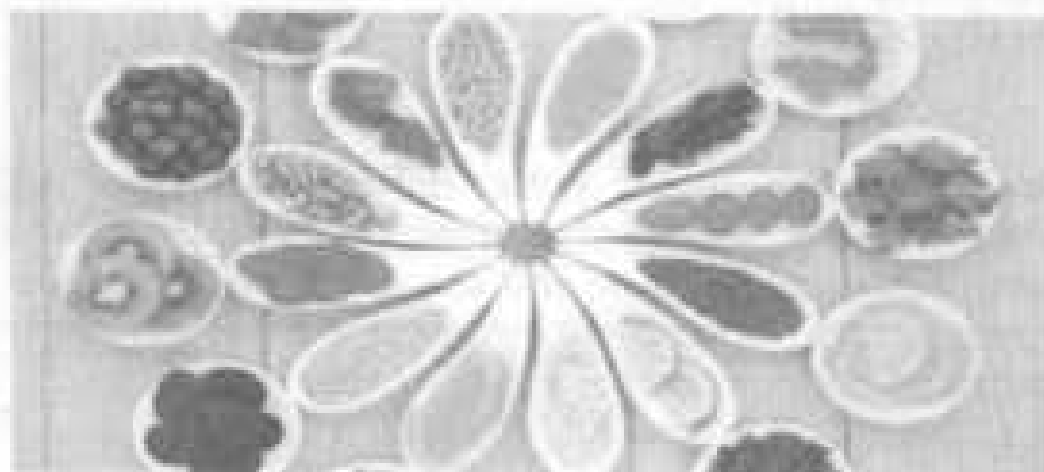
1 Citrus Fruits

All Citrus fruits are the house of Vitamin C, the most potent Antioxidant which is thought to increase the production of white blood cells, which are key to fighting infections. Its easy to add a squeeze of this vitamin to any meal. Popular Citrus fruits include: Grapefruit, Oranges, Lemons, Limes etc.

Both green and black tea are packed with flavonoids, a type of antioxidant which helps in enhancement of immune system. Green tea is also a good source of the amino acid L-theanine. L-theanine may aid in the production of germ-fighting compounds in T cells.

1. Spinach

Spinach is not just a rich source of vitamin C but also that of beta carotene which may both increase the infection-fighting ability of our immune system. Spinach is healthiest when its cooked as little as possible so that it retains its nutrients. However light cooking also makes it easier to absorb vitamin A and allows other anti-nutrients (not required by the body) like oxalic acid to get eliminated.



ANTIVIRAL FOODS

1. Garlic: Therapeutic value of garlic is because of its antimicrobial, anticancer, antioxidant, cholesterol lowering & anti-inflammatory properties. The active components present are allicin, selenium, ajoene & thiocremone.

2. Ginger: It contains effective antioxidants such as gingerol, shogaol & Vitamin C. Ginger may help reduce inflammation.

GENERAL GUIDELINES

Avoid food waste: Buy & prepare food as per your family need hence it allows access of food to needy.

Be frugal: Use fresh food first.

Go for home food & family meals: All of us have ample time to cook food and enjoy it with your children on table. Also involve your kids in cooking & teach them food safety.

Cautious about portion size: Work from home may lead to overeating. Don't make eating as a leisure task to be done. Listen to your inner hunger cues. Only eat when your stomach feels so and not your tongue. Identify your stomach capacity and eat that much only. Anything in excess is always dangerous.

Good food handling practices: Cleaning & sanitizing home as well as premise is important. Keep separate raw and cooked foods. Store leftover food to refrigerator (Below 5 C). Cook all food in potable water.

Be Hydrated: water is essential for all vital events happening in our body. Water is the media where all chemical reactions of our body takes place. Thus water is very much critical for maintaining health. An adult should drink at least 2-3 litres of water per day.

Say no to alcohol: Excess consumption of alcohol weakens immune system & makes certain drugs less effective.

Limit salt, sugar & fat intake: Take salt 5g/day, limit sugar up to 5% of total energy (approx 6 teaspoon) & take fat 30% of total energy (from this 10% will be saturated fat).

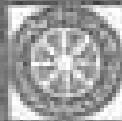

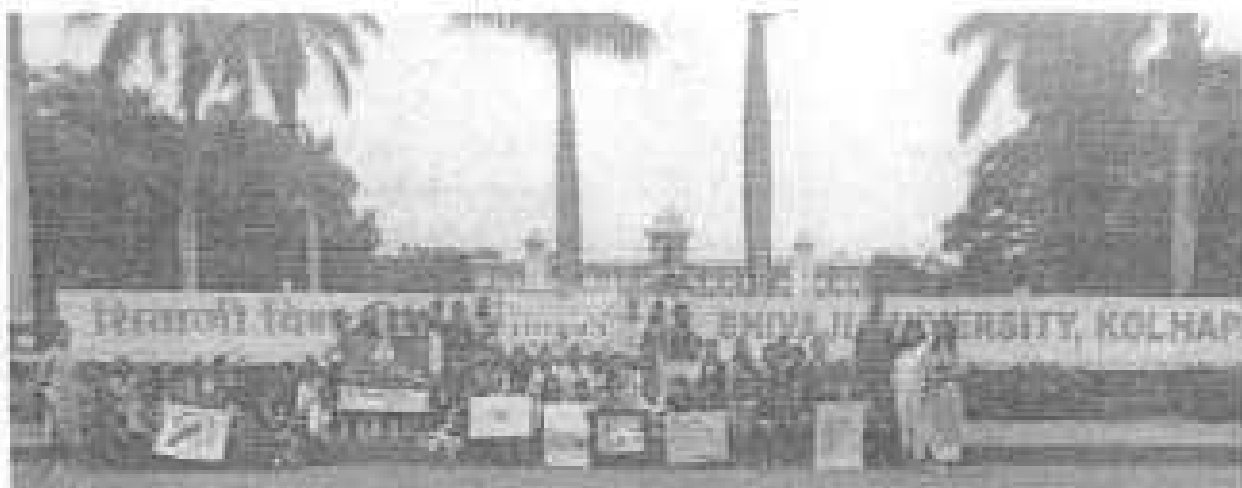
REPORT OF 'Literacy and Multilingualism' Day

- An interactive session was held for students.

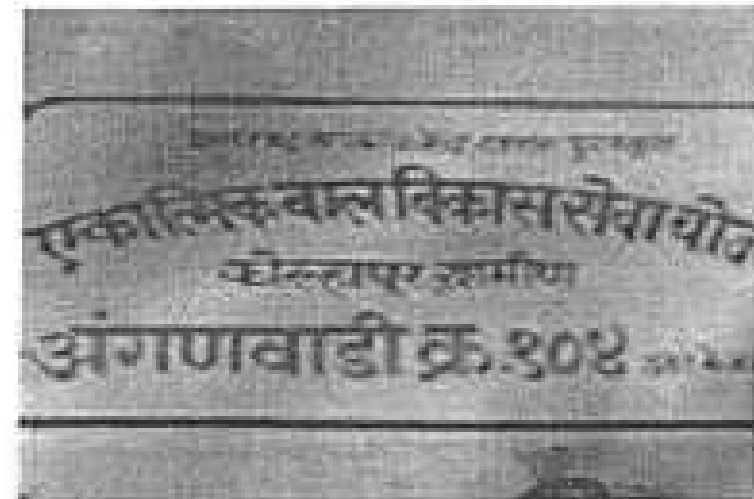

- Drinking from a water fountain
- Hugging, kissing, or shaking hands
- Sharing eating utensils
- Using exercise equipment at a gym

You can get it from infected blood, semen, vaginal fluid, or breast milk.

Mosquitoes spread HIV.

Because the virus is passed through blood, people have worried that they could get it from biting or bloodsucking insects.

When bugs bite, they don't inject the blood of the person or animal they bit before you. Also, HIV lives for only a short time inside them.

3. Upload Photograph or Video at the end of the event on fitindia.gov.in and Fit India facebook page.
4. Identify track / field for the Fit India Run and if possible create a map.
5. Wherever required, inform police for traffic management.
6. Inform local bodies to place large empty garbage collection containers at the finish point.
7. During Fit India Run do not use plastic (e.g. bottles and cups). Avoid use of Plastic. Participants could carry jute/plastic bags, gloves and other necessary equipment required for flogging (plastic collection).
8. Inform communities around you of the Fit India Run.
9. Encourage participation for atleast 1 adult family member along with child from every family.
10. Schools within the radius of 5km can organize joint Flogging for all the children in the schools.
11. Partner with local businesses to sponsor FIT INDIA T-shirts/caps for children.

Report on workshop

On 'Yuva Mahiladoot'

One day workshop on 'Yuva Mahiladoot' was conducted in Nilambari Greh, History Department, Shivaji University.

The Directorate General of Information and Public Relations, with the support of UNICEF and active participation of Higher and Technical Education Department has started 'Yuva Mahiladoot' initiative. The purpose of this initiative is to increase volunteerism among youths and to disseminate information about various Government schemes directly to the prospective beneficiaries through the students at graduate and postgraduate level in different streams in colleges all over Maharashtra.

Presently, information about government schemes is disseminated mainly through the newspapers, television channels and radio and other traditional mass media. The prospective beneficiaries of Government schemes are mostly less educated and are from Below Poverty Line. Many of them reside in remote areas where newspapers, television or radio are not used. The Government schemes which need to reach the prospective beneficiaries, will be taken to them through the enthusiastic youths through this initiative.

Following Key points were explained:

One 'Guide' will be appointed for the participating students from each college.

Special Mobile Application has been developed for the implementation of this initiative. This Mobile Application have accounts of the Citizens, Guides, Co-ordinators and participating students of each college.

College students will be able to register their names through this Application.

All details of the information to be given to the household, including scheme details, video, FAQs are included in this Application. Necessary documents/papers to get the benefits of the schemes, contact details of the Government offices concerned are also given.

The Mahiladoot will register the details of the households in the Mobile Application, after meeting them in person and will make them understand the detailed information about the schemes with the help of the Application.

Mahiladoot will encourage the households to get the Mobile Application downloaded. Prospective beneficiaries will be able to get information relating to all the Government schemes at one place.

Registration of all the guides, coordinators, Mahiladoots, proposed beneficiaries, will be related to their mobile number.

There are around 25 to 30 schemes concerning different categories (Farmers, Women, Tribals, Minorities, Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes etc.) have been given in this Mobile Application.

Notes :

1) The District Information Officer:

The District Information Officer will be nodal officer for this initiative.



2) Guide:

A Guide will be appointed by the college Principal from among teaching or non-teaching officer/employee. The Guide will register himself through the ID and password given by the Higher and Technical Education Department.

The Guide will approve the students who have applied to become "Mahiti Doot" from the college, in the mobile application itself.

3) Co-ordinators:

Persons having the basic knowledge of Government schemes and Government machinery and willing to do honorary social work will be selected as Coordinator. S/He will register himself/herself in the Mobile Application. The District Information Officers concerned will select the Co-ordinators in their districts, who will coordinate with Mahiti Doots, Beneficiaries and District Information Officers. If any household is interested in availing of a particular scheme, the Co-ordinator will help the household in this regard.

4) Yuva Mahiti Doot:

Any college student can register himself/herself to work voluntarily as Mahiti Doot on the Application. After receiving the approval by the college Guide, s/he will work as Mahiti Doot. During the period of the program, s/he will visit 50 households of proposed beneficiaries and give them information on Government schemes applicable to them. The 'Mahiti Doot' will get an opportunity to work at grassroots level for the State Government. They will be given identity as 'Yuva Mahiti Doot' by the State Government for a period of six months. After completion of the given work, they will be given Government Digital Certificate.
