



Warm greetings to all!

Conventional Vocational Courses for Woman, Kolhapur for inviting me to be a part of this convocation ceremony being held today. I am glad to note that the visionary Prof. Dr. A. D. The hard and sincere efforts done by you have paid dividends. Your academic efforts of last three years have come to fruition and you are getting ready to step out from the comfort of this campus into an Indian brimming with opportunities and possibilities. You are commencing your journey of translating your education and skill for the benefit of the world.

Convocation is a special day in the calendar of every institution of learning. It marks the culmination of a phase of learning and after having satisfied that the students are now ready to move on further in life and contribute to the world at large, as worthy individuals in the chosen domain of learning and training. The teachers give the final advice and blessings for further journey that students are embarking upon. It is solemn occasion for the students as also for the teachers. The bond



between the teachers and the students, which is supposed to have been built through years of mentoring, brings in an emotional content to convocation day. I wish to use this occasion to appreciate all members of the faculty who in their own way have contributed in shaping the young minds while they are with the institution.

I am reminded of a Sanskrit sloka that glorifies the educated person: Swagruhe poojyate Jheshtha; swagramme poojyate prabhuhu; swadeshe poojyate raja; vidwan sarvatra poojyate (The eldest is respected in the house; the head — villager is respected in his own village; a king is respected in his country; a learned person is however respected everywhere). Graduation is a watershed event in one's life. On this important day, it is worthwhile to ponder over what the purpose of all these years of education has been, and how you can use your education to make a difference to society.

Progress is based on dreams and requires change. Change requires learning. Education is about learning to learn. I recall the words of Eric Hoffer who said: In a time of drastic change, it is the learners who



inherit the future. The learned usually find themselves equipped to live in a world that no longer exists. Indeed, we live in a world where change is everywhere and constant learning is essential. In today's world, natural resources or military strenghth do not determine the pace of a nation's progress. Education does. Education is about rising the confidence of an individual to think a worthy dream and to translate that dreams to reality by high performance action. It is about opening up one's mind to accept new ideas, to evaluate them and to use them for progress. In a country like India, where 28% of the youth is illiterate, you must be grateful to your parents, your teachers and your country for providing you with this instrument of education i.e. degree.

Earlier few decades ago, after independence there were only two important constituents in higher education like knowledge taker: the students and second, the knowledge provider: the teachers. It went on for long time because that was the era after independence and the main task for the nation like India was educating the non-educators i.e. "Sarv-



shiksha Abhiyan". Under this mission, the main motto was "Teach oneeach". After completion of this mission, there was a third need in higher education i.e. the generation of new knowledge. In view of this, it is parameter of research is added into the higher education. The government has made it mandatory to every higher education institute/college/University and can get 'A' grade accreditation from NAAC. Hence students, teachers and researchers have become the integrated part in higher education. This has helped to generate new knowledge, numbers of Ph.D thesis and research papers. But this has created another problem of highly educated unemployment for the nation. In view of this, since last two years, the entrepreneurship development. Thus presently in higher education there are four parameters named as:

- 1. Knowledge Taker- Student
- 2. Knowledge Provider- Teacher
- 3. Knowledge Generator- Researchers
- 4. Knowledge Converter into Technology- Technologist.



It is our responsibility to raise India to ranks of the developed nations. In a civilized society, every individual has to give back to the society, in some form or other, more than what he or she has received from it. That is how countries achieve progress. Every hardworking, sincere and honest citizen-teachers, politicians, bureaucrats, military personnel, professionals, administrative staff and janitors, just to name a few professions- has an important role in this undertaking. Nobody is too small for this task.

However, the educated ones among us have benefited from the sacrifices of our less fortunate brethren and have a greater opportunity and a greater responsibility to contribute to society. If we have to eradicate poverty from this country, we need a new Indian mindset for the 21st century. Let me talk a little about the cardinal attributes of this mindset.

This thing does not happen because of mere speeches and slogans. They happen because of performance. Unless you translate your aspirations to actions they do not mean a thing. I want you to remember that performance leads to recognition. Recognition leads to respect.



Respect leads to power. Therefore, my friends there are only one way to make India a powerful nation. That is through performance. Aspirational performance requires that you create aspirational targets, and work hard, fast, smart, honest and in a disciplined manner over a long period of time to achieve these targets. Remember that discipline, speed of decision making and velocity of action are necessary attributes for high performance.

These days, most aspirational tasks are huge and need team work. Team work requires you to rise above gender, caste, religion, race, regionalism and nationality. To do so, you must subordinate your ego and eliminate bias by deciding every issue using data and facts in an environment of courtesy and dignity, openness, fairness, transparency, accountability and meritocracy. You have to be generous and share credit with other members of the team. You have to create trust and confidence in them through your actions.

Remember that this institution has given you a passport to better respect and prosperity for yourself. The hallmark of a civilized individual is to show gratitude to those that has made you more than

what you were. Therefore, please contribute generously to make this institution stronger to serve even a larger number of smart people like you.

Let me finally close with yet another Sanskrit sloka that summarises all that I said today. Ahimsaa prathamam pushpam; pushpam indriya sarvbhootha dayaa pushpam; nigraham; kshmaa pushpam shanthi,dhyanaa,dhanaa visheshsthaha; pushpa thathaivacha; sathyam ashtavidham pushpam; vishnum praseedham kareth (Nonviolence, controlling the sensual desires, forbearance, forgiveness, peace, mediation, charity and truth are the eight kinds of flowers that pleases lord Vishnu). Indeed, these attributes characterize the ideal Indian of the 21st century.

You are the best among the best – the chosen few. You are in a unique position to change the course of India and perhaps even the world. I have no doubt at all that you will serve as role models for the 21st century Indian and will help the larger masses realize the power of such a mindset. This is the only way we can redeem the pledge of our founding fathers. Best wishes and
