Observations / suggestions given by students to improve the overall teaching - learning experience in the institution:
Student Satisfaction Survey was carried out in prescribed format through google platform. As per the requirement third year students and PG students were taken as the respondents. A total of 110 students out of 169 (65,08%) responded to the survey. The responses were taken on 4 point scale for interpreting the data, five classes were identified.

70 - 80	B - Very Good
60 - 70	C- Good
50 - 60	D - Poor

The average score of the SSS on all questions was 77.2% that is very good response on teaching learning process. The data with two highest scores of 84.80 and 84.34 indicates excellent communication of teachers with students and completion of syllabus by the teachers in time. Two minimum scores were 68.43 and 72.61 for promoting internships, mentoring process for emotional growth and maximum use of ICT by teachers while teaching.

Suggestions made by the Students: More emphasis should be given on

- 1) Strengthening personality development programs, communication and soft skills.
- 2) More efforts to be taken by college for placements and internships.
- 3) More time for practical, industry visits and fieldwork.

Two minimum scores were 73.5 & 72.5 for mentoring process for social emotional growth and percentage of ICT tools respectively. From SSS it is concluded that ICT facility in classrooms, promoting internship, student exchange field opportunities and mentoring process be strengthened. Suggestions made by the Students: More emphasis should be given on

1) Strengthening Personality Development Programmes.

2) Mobile should be banned to carrry with them during lecture hours.

3) More efforts to be taken by college for internships.
