A Report on International Yoga Day Celebration on 21st June 2021

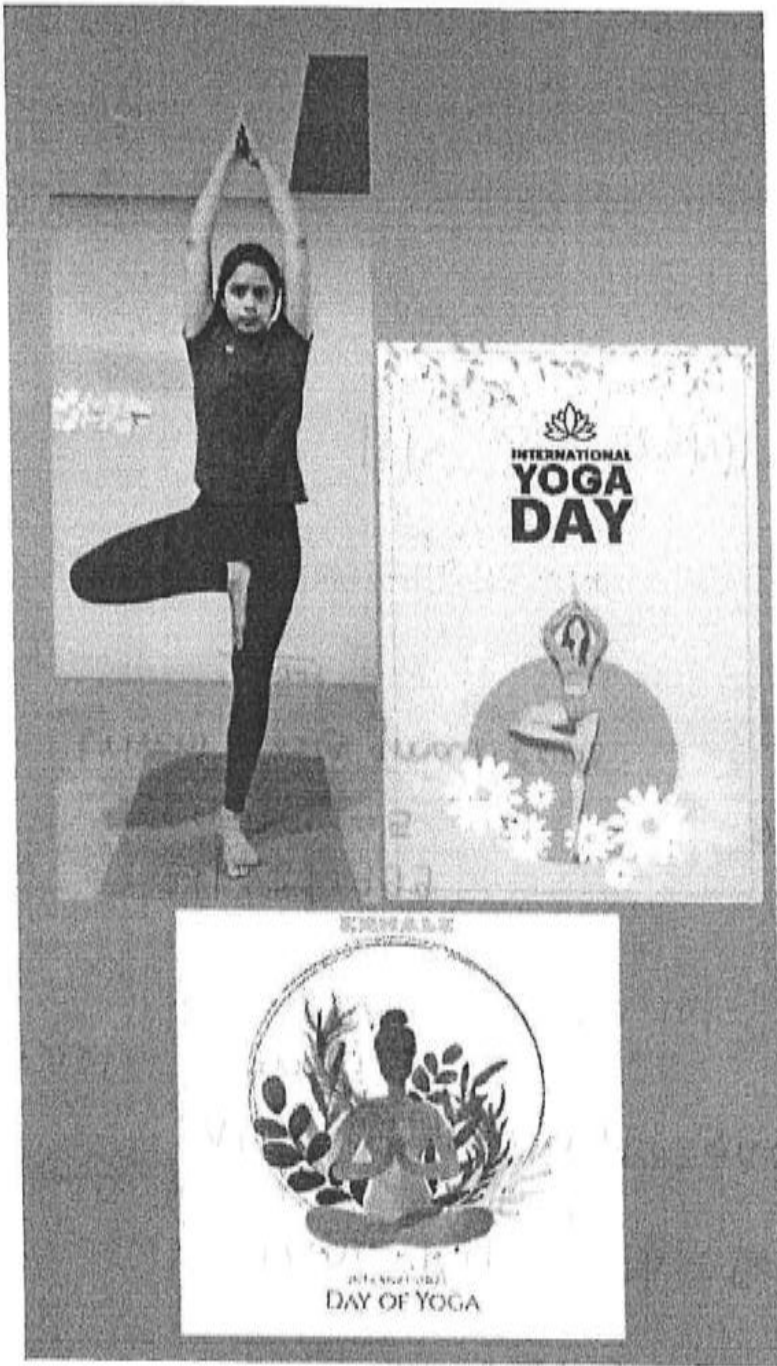

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



















LITERACY: ITS IMPORTANCE AND CHANGES IN THE CONCEPT

The Department of Fashion Design had organized Online guest lecture using Zoom platform, of Ms. Vaishali Menon, Design Educator, Bangluru.



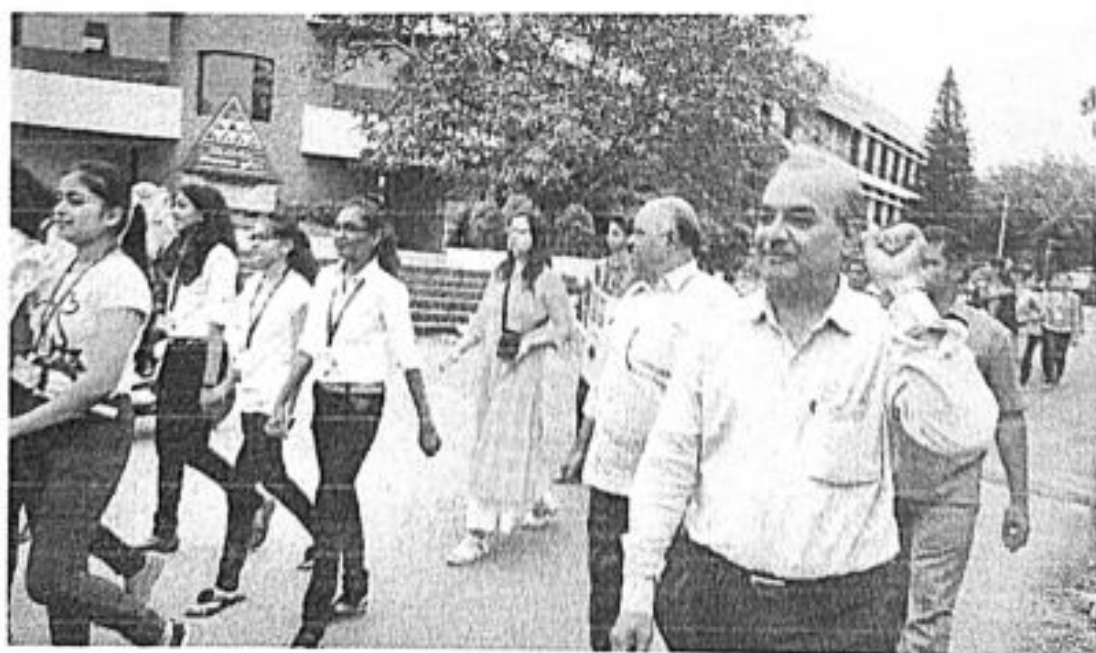
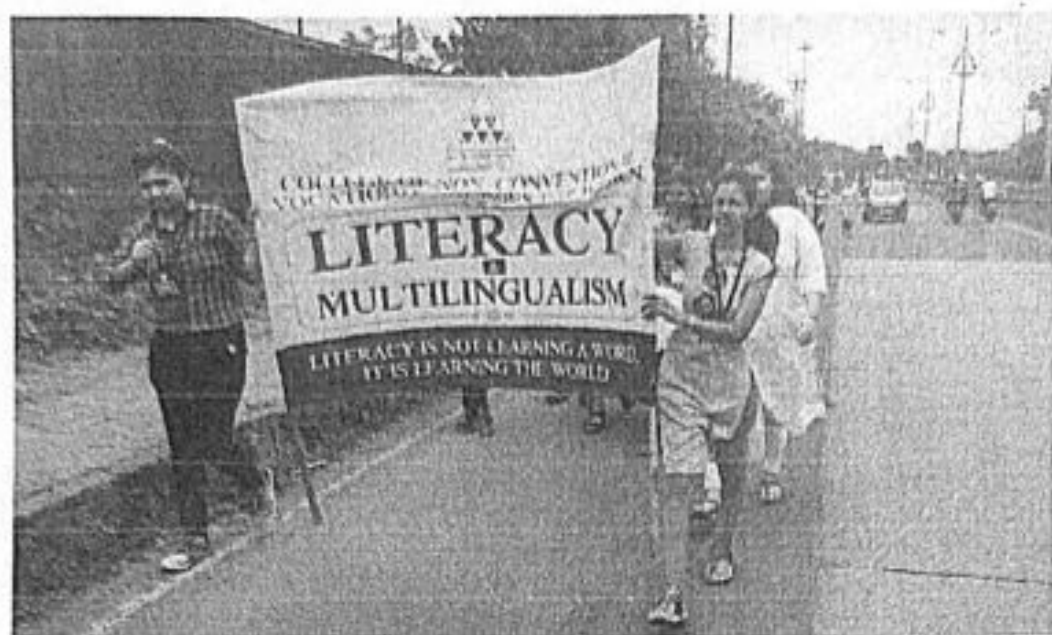
REPORT OF 'Literacy and Multilingualism' Day

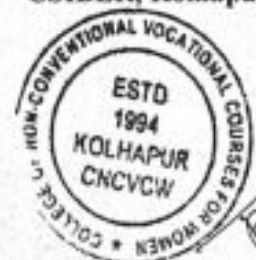

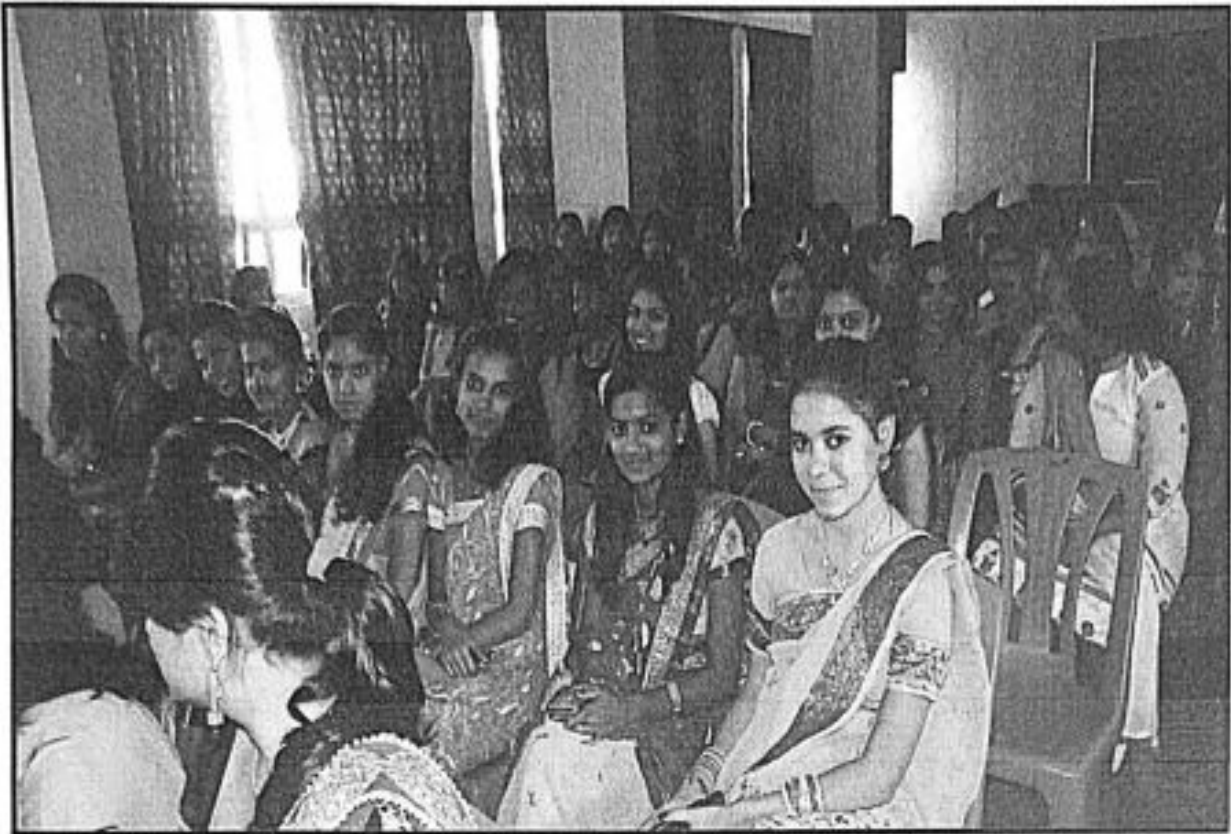

For this Workshop about 15 Teaching and Non-teaching staff was presented. The event was conducted successfully with sheer participation and awareness for health.

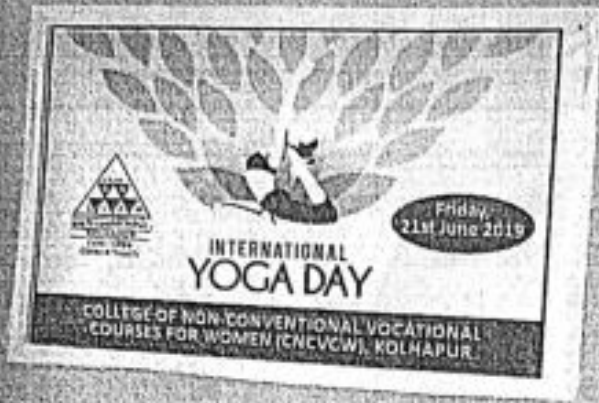
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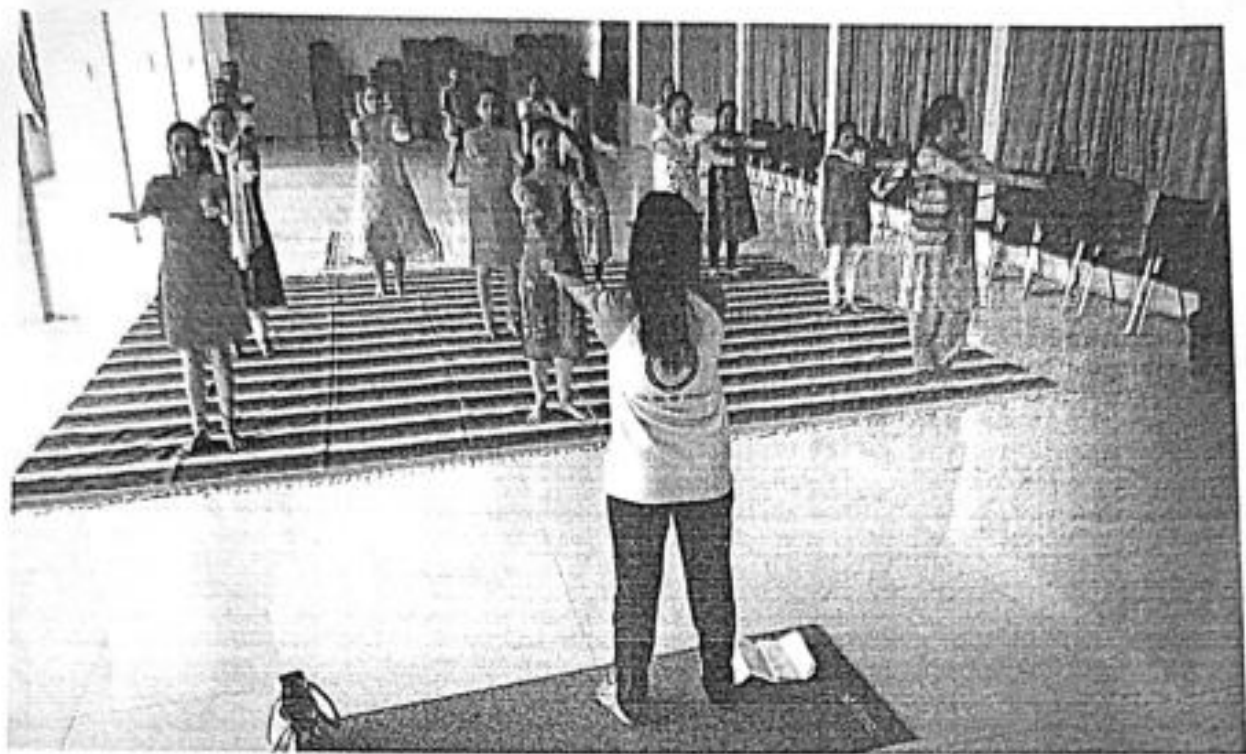
